No charge for entering tournament – but only open to SFEC members

There is no need to bring your catch to an official weigh-in station. You are on the honor system

Just weigh the fish and then e-mail sfec@comcast.net your name, the weight and species (type of fish) and date caught, along with a picture.

It is mandatory that you email a picture of your catch with the date, weight and species caught

Award will be given for heaviest Tuna and heaviest Mahi
